Ski Trips

The ski trip to Ramsau took place again from 7th – 14th January 2023.

27 people took part and 4 instructors – Adam Pinney, Peter Moysey, Dagmar Junghanns and Mary Wray. This was a tuition week and all levels were catered for. It proved very popular and will be held again in 2024 with a similar format. There was a lack of snow this year and the race was postponed until March, so hopefully we will have better weather next year.

Plans were made early in 2023 for next season's trips, and with enlisted help from others willing to organise an event, there will be an early on-snow trip in December 2023 with tuition if required, and one to Switzerland in February 2024 which is purely recreational.
